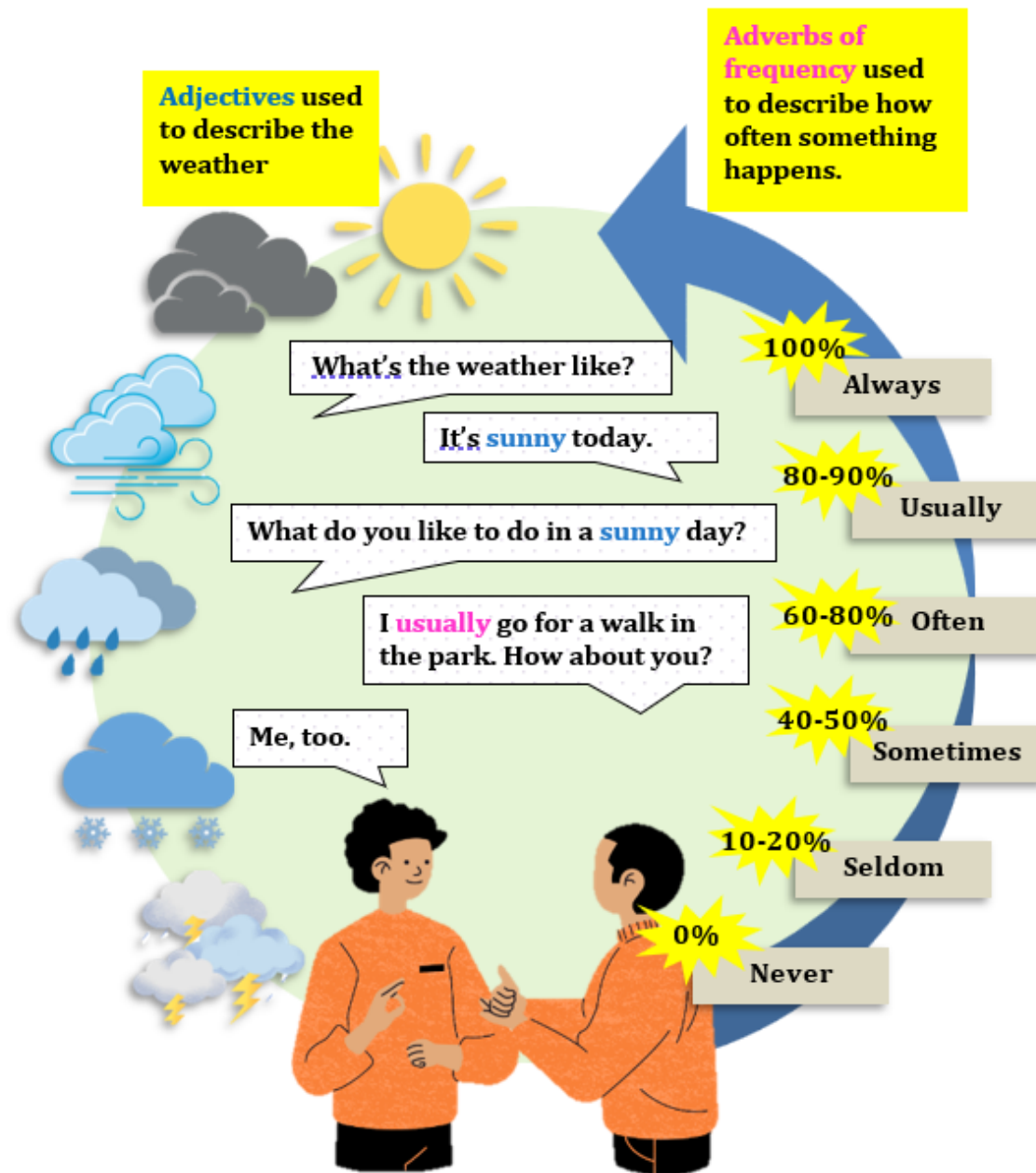

After verb to be

The weather is stormy, we should stay home.

The sky is clear today.

Note Don't use "a", "an", "the"

before adjectives when they are
not followed by nouns.

It is ~~a~~ hot in April.

Is it ~~a~~ cold outside?

The weather is ~~an~~ overcast, it
may be raining outside.

4.2 Adverbs of frequency used to describe how often something happens

Adverbs of frequency go before verbs or after be.

We **usually** go shopping when the sky is clear.

It **often** snows in December.

She is **always** full of energy.

1. always	Something happens 100% . It always rains in the rainy season.
2. usually	Something happens around 80-90% . It usually gets hot in April, so it is a popular month for beach outings.
3. often	Something happens around 60-80% . It often rains in October.
4. sometimes	Something happens around 40-50% . I sometimes go cycling when the sky is clear.
5. seldom	Something happens around 10-20% . I seldom go to the gym when the weather is cloudy.
6. never	Something happens around 0% . I never go for a walk after work.

Weather in Thailand
