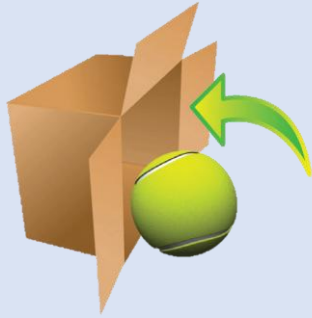

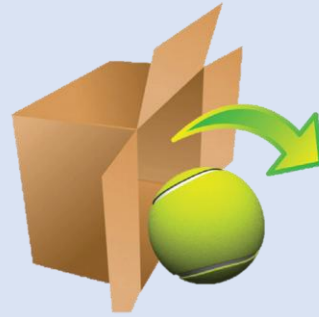

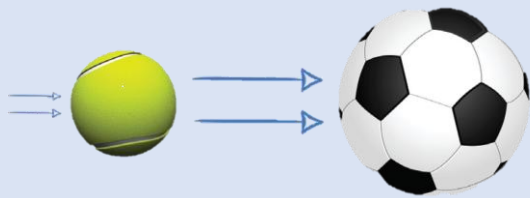

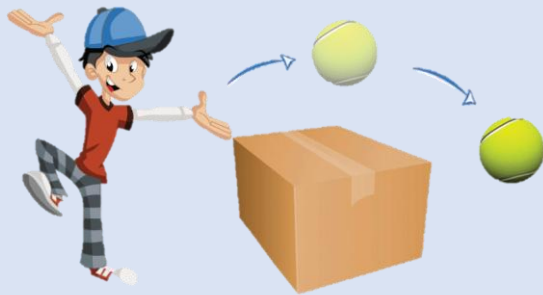

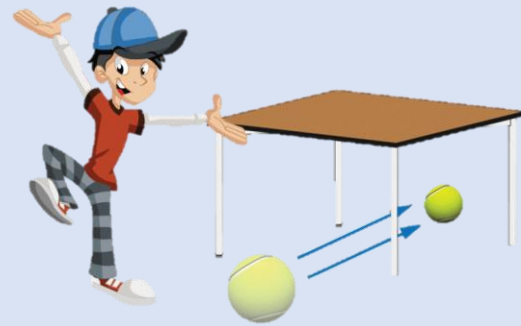

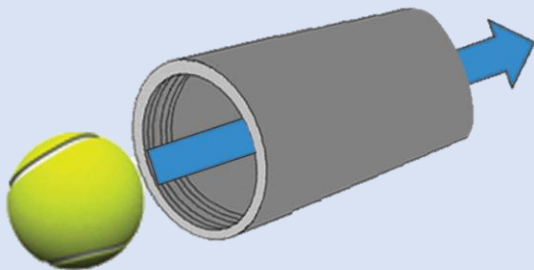

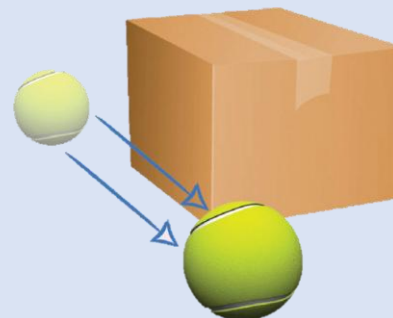

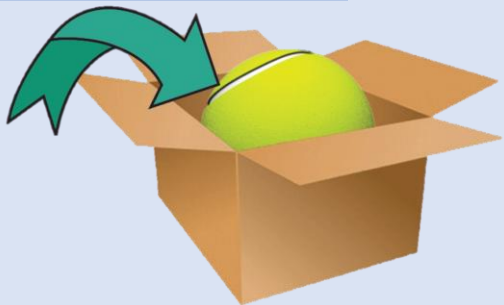

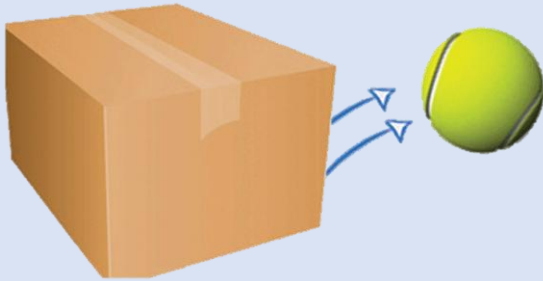
The ball is getting onto the box.

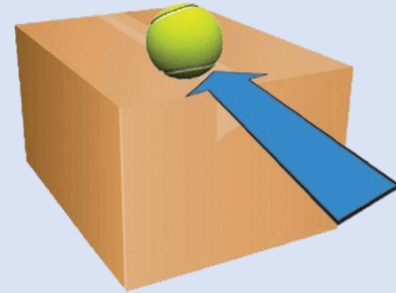
